

All watched the footy finals, at the end of the day some were happy & some were not.


Thanks to all the wonderful Ladies who cooked all the morning & afternoon teas, no one was hungry.

Helen and I joined the club back in 2008 as we had recently purchased our first van, a second hand 19 footer from Jayco Sydney and were looking to find a club with like minded individuals who were happy to

show us newbies the ins and outs of vanning. Our first and much looked forward to Rally was at Burrill Lakes. Helen and I have met and made many friends, have travelled the country far and wide and continue looking forward to our club activities and further travels.

I am currently the Assistant Secretary and have previously spent several years as a committee member.

I was the assistant Scout Leader for 7 years at our local Ryde Scout group while our boys were in the cubs and scouts and found it a very rewarding experience.

Both Helen and I have been keen fishos, 4 WD'ers and love our gardening. I also enjoy lawn bowls and don't mind the opportunity to dine out with club members whilst on the road .

I am a 5th generation Butcher (now retired-most of the time) who spent over 30 years Teaching Butchery in TAFE NSW. During that time I also specialised in Smallgoods Manufacturing and Curriculum development where I was part of a very small team which completely redesigned the Apprenticeship Butchery Trade Course and an Advanced Trade Certificate at Certificate 4 Level. For many years I enjoyed working at the Royal Easter Show for what was then the Meat and Allied Trades (later AMIC- Australian Meat Industry Council). A small team of us would create a Butcher Shop in the Meat Pavillion where we would proceed to demonstrate where all the various cuts of meat came from and how best to cook and store meats. We also had lots of fun showing everyone how we made sausages and often helped those who were showing their livestock and living within the showgrounds at Moore Park.

Recipe for the Month

Pikelets, supplied by Sue Bradshaw.

One large banana or 2 small ones
1 cup of self raising flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
2 dessertspoons caster sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
2 tablespoons melted butter
1 large egg & 1 cup of milk

Sift all dry ingredients, mash bananas with sugar & vanilla

Add beaten egg & milk. Combine wet & dry ingredients

Add melted butter. Stand for 15-20 minutes.

Fry in melted butter till golden.

Whip small bottle of cream with vanilla.

Serve Pikelets with whipped cream & golden syrup drizzled over the cream.
