

Tuesday night the remaining members went to the Norah Head Sportie for pizza and other meals.

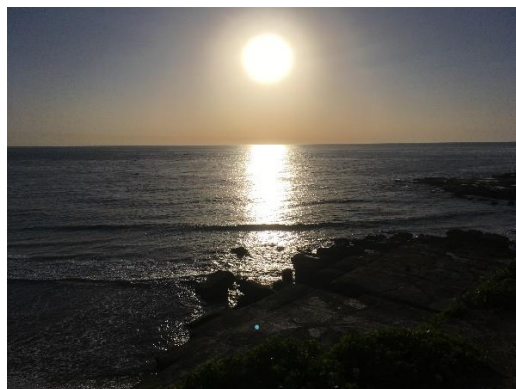
On Wednesday the remaining vans (except Helen and Paul) packed up and headed home looking forward to our next rally at Gilgandra.

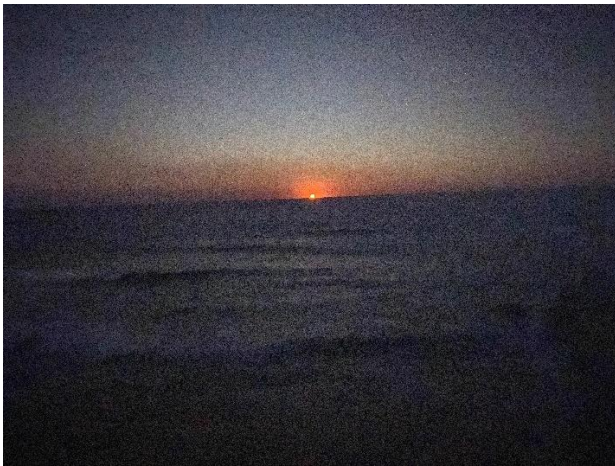

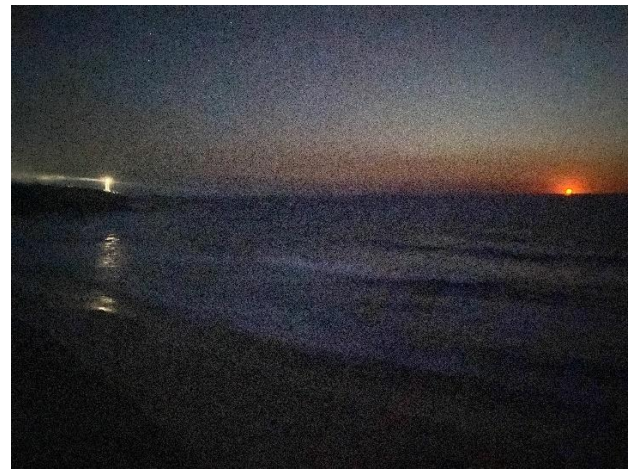
